



Safety Plan for the 2020 Parisian Flea Market

- Entry/Exit: The front doors will be used as an entrance only. The back door will be used as an exit only.
- Taped directional arrows will be placed throughout the venue to indicate traffic flow and prevent clumping of shoppers/volunteers.
- Signs will be posted with the following: 1) If you are sick, do not enter (at entry); 2) Masks Required (at entry); 3) Social Distancing / Stay 6 feet apart (at entry and throughout venue).
- All volunteers and shoppers will be required to wear masks.
- Cash will be accepted for tickets and merchandise; all volunteers handling cash will be provided with gloves to wear.
- Plexiglass will be placed at the checkout counter.
- Volunteers will be placed at both entrances to keep an accurate count of the number of people in the venue using a people-counter app.
- The number of people inside the venue will be limited based on the percentage of the venue's capacity that is specified in current guidelines.
- At entry, a volunteer will be stationed to provide hand sanitizer to every person entering (all should use) and to provide a mask if they don't already have one (all entrants 8 years or older must wear a mask in venue).
- Volunteers will be asked to self-monitor if they are sick or have a temperature and asked NOT to come if they do. All volunteers will be asked to wear a mask in the venue and to sanitize hands frequently.
- Frequently-touched surfaces will be sanitized regularly (hourly at a minimum), especially at entrances and exits; at check-out; at the hold table; and throughout the venue.
- Bathrooms: A volunteer will be stationed at the bathroom to provide hand sanitizer to each person when entering and exiting the bathroom. Signs will be posted inside the bathrooms asking people to use toilet paper to contact the surface when flushing and to use a paper towel to contact the surface when using the faucet. Frequently-touched surfaces will be sanitized hourly.
